1 - Box of Tissues

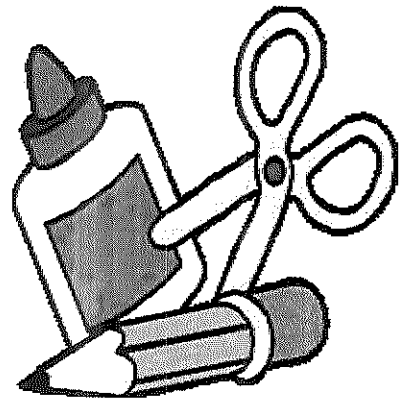
1 – Pencil Box
