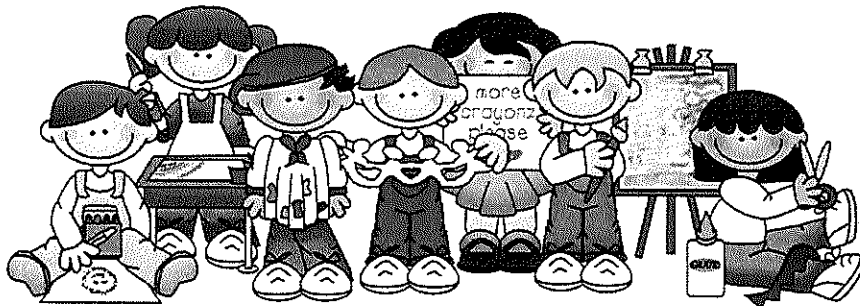

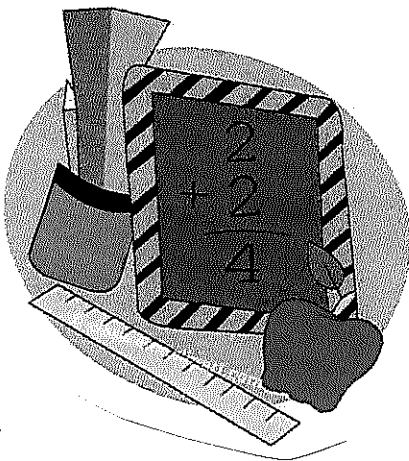

First Grade School Supply List 2018-2019

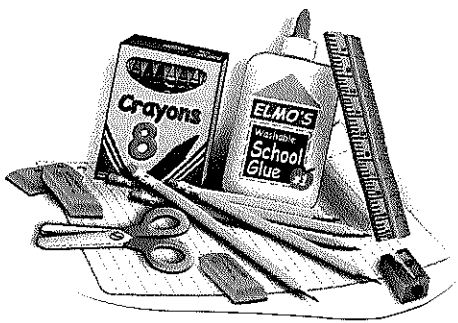
Every Firstie Needs to Bring:

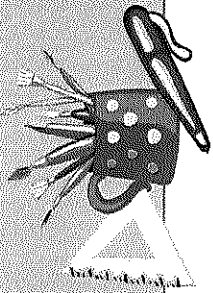
All supplies are community supplies and are shared throughout the year. Please purchase non-decorative items and not items that are “special” for your student because student will SHARE.

EACH STUDENT SHOULD HAVE A BACKPACK.

- 6 - Composition notebooks (prefer on grid-lined for math)

- 48 - #2 Pencils (Ticonderoga is best)

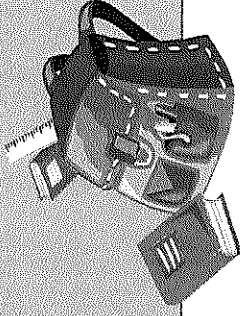

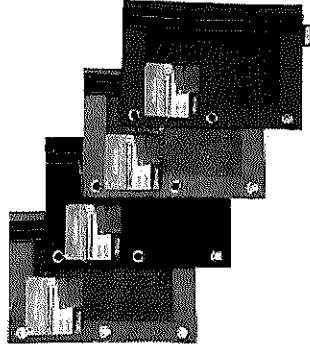

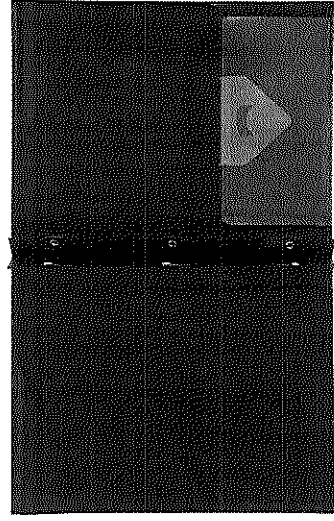
